1.	Project display is no more that 36 inches in width Projects cannot exceed 30 inches in depth or be more than 6 feet tall.
	Projects cannot weigh more than 150 pounds .
2.	Construction of project is self-supporting. All valuable items are secured to project or brought to interview.
3.	If electricity is needed, a grounded extension cord must be <u>provided by student exhibitor</u> .
4.	No living preserved organisms (including plants, animals, or microbes); preserved vertebrate or invertebrate animals (including embryos); dried plant materials; taxidermy specimens or parts; human or animal parts; and human or animal food or wrappers/containers can be exhibited.
5.	No soil or waste samples, chemicals, powders, or liquids (including water); food, poisons, drugs, controlled substances; dry ice or other sublimating substances; flammable or combustible materials, liquids of gases; and sharp hazardous, or dangerous items are displayed. No aggregate (concrete et al) substances can be displayed. NO general laboratory equipment may be displayed unless it is critical or unique to the final result or product (no scales, safety glasses, lab equipment, measuring devices, etc.) Any electronic devices needed to demonstrate project must have prior approval to be carried in on judging day.
6.	Student name and school is NOT visible on display. Student number SHOULD be on display.
7.	Neither early nor late entries will not be accepted. I understand that my project must stay on exhibit for the duration of the fair and failure to remove the project display by the clean-up deadline will result in loss of the entire display. All materials not attached to the display board will be removed after judging interviews.
8.	Project journal and research report are displayed on table in front of project and are to be labeled ONLY with project number. I understand the journal is 15% of the total score. Electronic journals must be printed.
9.	Summary form and research journal displayed in front of project board.
